Is student engagement different from adult engagement? Regardless of the answer, how do we plan for both? Do engaged learners (student and adult) look and act different from those simply going through the motions of school? As teachers, we must first define the qualities that bring about increased student engagement and content understanding. As coaches and administrators, we must give teachers practical applications of the qualities and foster them across grade levels and disciplines and learn how to look for these qualities in the classroom.

On November 16<sup>th</sup> John Antonetti will help us with these pertinent issues. Mr. Antonetti is a national speaker who has taught at all grade levels, served as system Curriculum Director and a Gifted Supervisor for 18 school districts, and has been a lead developer and trainer in the process of classroom walk-throughs. He provides schools with on-site instructional analysis and follow-up support and is the author of the book, *Writing as a Measure and Model of Thinking*.

- How to empower students through written personal response
- How to integrate engaging qualities with high-yield strategies to increase rigor
