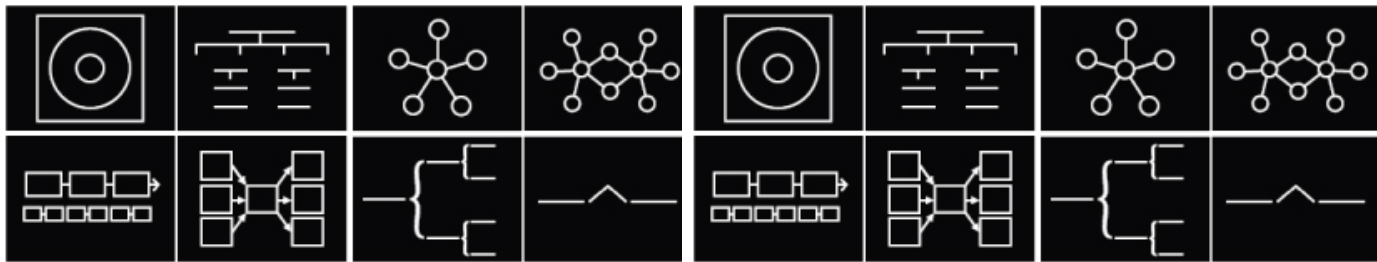

Thinking Maps[®] 4 Mathematics

CSRA RESA will host, **Thinking Maps 4 Mathematics**, on **April 27-28, 2010**. The workshop will train participants on the effective use of the Maps in secondary Mathematics. Participants will learn the impact that visuals, color-coding, meta cognitive reflection and mathematical language have on student learning and processing. Examples created by teachers and students will be showcased and used to guide participants in building units that align with the GPS.

The workshop will be facilitated by Thinking Maps Florida Marketing Representative, James Dean. Mr. Dean taught in the Palm Beach County School System for ten years and served as a Mathematics Supervisor for K-12 schools. He will use his hands-on experience as a classroom teacher and his expertise in using Thinking Maps to provide practical strategies for secondary math teachers.

All Participants must be trained in using Thinking Maps and must bring their Language for Learning manuals. Teachers are also encouraged to bring textbooks and/or curriculum guides as well as copies of the GPS to assist in developing units.
